In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 25 of the Goa Tax on Entry of Goods Act, 2000 (Goa Act No. 14 of 2000) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act") read with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act No. 10 of 1897), the Government of Goa, hereby amends the Government Notification No. 5/11/2002-Fin (R&C) dated 19-05-2003 published in the Official Gazette, Extraordinary, Series II No. 7 dated 19-05-2003 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Notification"), as follows:—

In the said Notification, in the SCHEDULE, against serial number (3), in column (2), for the expression "Glass bottles, glass vials, glass ampoules, aluminium foil, aluminium collapsible tubes, aluminium pouches, hard gelatine capsules, soft gelatine capsules, ROPP caps, plastic measuring cups, labels and BOPP tapes, nylon straps, metal clips, cartons, paper bags, laminated packing material, such as, bituminize paper and hessgian based paper and the like", the expression "Glass

vials, glass ampoules, aluminium foil, aluminium collapsible tubes, aluminium pouches, hard gelatine capsules, soft gelatine capsules, labels and BOPP tapes, nylon straps, metal clips, paper bags, laminated packing materials, such as, bituminize paper and hessgian based paper and the like" shall be substituted.

This Notification shall come into force with effect from 01-04-2012.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Goa Tax on Entry of Goods Act, 2000 (Goa Act No. 14 of 2000) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), the Government of Goa, hereby specifies that, a tax shall be levied and collected under the said Act on entry of goods specified in column (2) of the table below, into every local area, for consumption, use or sale

therein, at the rates specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) of the said table.

(1)	Naphtha used as raw material by chemical fertilizer industry	15%
(2)	Light Motor Vehicle costing more than Rs. 15 lakhs and two wheeler i.e. Motorcycle or Scooter, costing more than Rs. 2 lakhs	15%
(3)	Plastic measuring cups, droppers, bottles, caps, cases for rapid diagnostic kits	5%

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Goa Tax on

Entry of Goods Act, 2000 (Goa Act No. 14 of 2000) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act") read with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act No. 10 of 1897), the Government of Goa, hereby amends the Government Notification No. 5/7/2000-Fin(R&C)(6) dated 14-11-2000, published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary) Series I No. 32 dated 14-11-2000 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Notification"), as follows:—

In the said Notification in the TABLE,—

(i) against serial number (20),—

(a) in column (2), for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:—

"motor vehicles (all kinds) and parts and accessories thereof including chassis of motor vehicles but other than, light motor vehicles costing more than ₹15 lakhs, and two wheelers i.e. Motorcycles or Scooters costing more than ₹ 2 lakhs.";

(b) in column (3), for the expression "twelve paise in a rupee", the expression "twelve and half paise in a rupee" shall be substituted.

(ii) against serial number (24), in column (2), in item (v) the expression "glass bottles," shall be omitted;

(iii) against serial number (34), in column (3), for the expression "Three paise in every ten rupees", the expression "Two paise in a rupee" shall be substituted.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Goa Tax on Entry of Goods Act, 2000 (Goa Act No. 14 of 2000) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act") read with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act No. 10 of 1897), the Government of Goa, hereby amends the Government Notification No. 5/7/2000-FIN(R&C)(9) dated 06-12-2000, published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 37 dated 14-12-2000 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Notification"), as follows:—

In the said Notification in the TABLE for the existing entries against serial No. (i), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

- "(1) Motor Vehicles (all kinds) and parts and accessories thereof including chassis of motor vehicles but other than, Light Motor Vehicles costing more than Rs. 15 lakhs, and two wheelers i.e. Motorcycles or Scooters costing more than Rs. 2 lakhs 12.5%
- (2) Light Motor Vehicles costing more than Rs. 15 lakhs and two wheelers i.e. Motorcycles or Scooters, costing more than Rs. 2 lakhs 15%"

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 78 of the Indian Registration Act, 1908 (Central Act XVI of 1908), the Government of Goa hereby amends the Table of Fees, published in the Government Gazette (Supplement) Series I, No. 31 dated 1-11-1965, as follows, namely:—

In the Table of Fees,—

1. In Article 1,—

in item 4, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

"(a) If the amount of value of the consideration or of the property to which such instrument relates, is wholly expressed therein;

	<u>On value</u>	<u>amount</u>
when the amount of value does not exceed ₹ 25 lakhs	—	2%
when the amount of value exceed ₹ 25 lakhs but does not exceed ₹ 50 lakhs	—	3%
when the amount of value exceed ₹ 50 lakhs but does not exceed ₹ 1 crore	—	4%
when the amount of value exceeds ₹ 1 crore	—	5%

*Note:* The fee specified above shall, however be subject to a maximum of ₹ 50 lakhs."

2. For Article XXII, the following Article shall be substituted, namely:—

"XXII. For the authentication or attestation of a General or a Special Power of Attorney ₹ 500/-.";

3. For Article XXVIII, the following Article shall be substituted, namely:—

“XXVIII. Fees for issue of Nil Encumbrance Certificate,—

Whereas the collections of fees of some items under the Notarial Code for Acts to be executed by Notaries as per Decree No. 8373, as specified in the SCHEDULE below are inconsistent with the present conditions and not commensurate with expenditure incurred for the maintenance of the relevant services;

And Whereas, it is deemed expedient by the Government of Goa to enhance the fees under NOTARIAL Code to meet the above conditions.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in it by clause 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu (Administration) Removal of Difficulties Order, 1962, the Government of Goa hereby further amends the table of fees appended to the Diploma Legislative No. 2095 dated 24-6-1961, published in the Official Gazette, Series I, No. 25 dated the 24th June, 1961 (Supplement), as amended upto date, as follows, namely:—

1. In Article 1, for the letters and figures “₹ 20/-”, the expression “₹ 500/- for the first Act and ₹ 250/- for the subsequent Act” shall be substituted.
2. In Article 3, — in clause (f), for the expression “₹ 25.00 and ₹ 10.00”, the letters and figures “₹ 500.00” shall be substituted.

Whereas, it has been noticed that the collection of fees as prescribed by the Diploma Legislative No. 1847 dated 6-11-1958 as in force in the State of Goa in respect of the registration of marriage, its transcription and such other connected matters and revised vide Notification No. 1/29-3/92/LD dated 31-3-1993, published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 52 dated 31-3-1993, Notification No. 5/40/98-LD (3047) dated 25-4-2001, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 6 dated 10-5-2001 and Notification No. 5/4/98-LD (3047) dated 7-1-2003, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 43 dated 23-1-2003, are inconsistent with the present conditions and not commensurate with the expenditure incurred for the maintenance of relevant services.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in it by clause 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu (Administration) Removal of Difficulties Order, 1962, and in supersession of the Notification No. 1/29-3/92/LD dated 31-3-1993, published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 52 dated 31-3-1993, Notification No. 5/40/98-LD (3047) dated 25-4-2001, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 6 dated 10-5-2001 and Notification No. 5/4/98-LD (3047) dated 7-1-2003, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 43 dated 23-1-2003, the Government of Goa hereby directs that the following fees shall be charged in respect of marriages and relevant certificates:—

6. For extract (certidao narrativa) of marriage register

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Goa Change of Name and Surname Act, 1990 (Goa Act 8 of 1990), the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa Change of Name and Surname Rules, 1991, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Change of Name and Surname (First Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 2012.

2. *Amendment of rule 3.*— In sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Goa Change of Name and Surname Rules, 1991, for the expression “thirty-six rupees”, the expression “one hundred rupees” shall be substituted.
